INTERBREED - CONDITIONS & INFORMATION

- By nominating you agree to have read and understand the Queensland Ag Shows Competition Rules & Regulations and agree to be bound in all respects by these Rules & By-Laws of Queensland Ag Shows. You also consent and agree that Queensland Ag Shows and Show Societies have the right to take or use photographs of me (and/or my property) and use the photos in any and all marketing and media worldwide including online, now or in the future.
- You acknowledge that it is a condition of competing in this competition that you do so at your own risk. You accept all risks and release the Society from all claims, demands and proceedings arising out of or connected with your competing in the Event and indemnify the Society together with any other organisation or person involved in the conduct of the Event against all liability for any injury, loss or damage arising out of or connected with my competing in the Event. This release continues forever and binds all of my heirs, successors, executors, personal representatives and assigns.
- All exhibitors in STUD classes must be able to deliver a Herd Book Certificate of each exhibit.
- Cattle Age as at 1st May 2026.
- Exhibitors are welcome to arrive on Monday 11th May 2026 from 9:00am. All entries must be on the grounds by 5:00pm Monday 11th May for judging to commence at 8:00am Tuesday. All cattle to remain on grounds until the completion of the beef section.
- All entries must be tied and will be paraded for judging.
- All stock must be free of ticks.
- All cattle over 12 months must wear a nose ring.
- All cattle must be dehorned or poll.
- All cattle must be NLIS compliant and be accompanied by a completed Waybill. PIC No. must be entered on nomination form.
- No drug, hormone or tranquillizer shall be administered to any animal exhibit unless under the direction of the association's Veterinarian who shall advise the Stewards if in their opinion such drug, hormone or tranquilizer is likely to have effect upon the animal which would be material to its chances of being awarded a prize and in such cases the Stewards may debar the animal from competing. A Steward may at any time direct the association's Veterinarian to take a sample of blood, saliva or urine from the exhibit for testing.
- If insufficient entries, the Committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes if necessary.
- Ribbons will be awarded to Third Place for the Feature and Interbreed classes.
- Some sawdust bedding will be supplied.
- Pair of Bulls - must be exhibited in their respective classes.
- Pair of Females - must be exhibited in their respective classes.
- Breeder's Group - to consist of three animals owned and bred by the exhibitor with both male and female progeny exhibited
- Progeny Stakes Group to consist of three animals both sexes to be represented all the progeny of one sire or dam, but not necessarily owned or bred by the exhibitor.
- The Most Successful Interbreed Exhibitor Award is awarded to the exhibitor with the highest accumulation of points.
- Led Trade Cattle Rules
- Open to any recognised breed or crosses thereof.
- Breed to be stated on the entry form.
- No horned cattle are allowed to compete.
- All steers/heifers will be weighed at 7.00am Tuesday 12th May 2026.
- All led trade cattle must be milk tooth.
- Judging will take place after the completion of the Interbreed Judging.
